

# Handling Inflation in 7 Months. Assessment of the 6 Governments


**Title:** *Inflation in the first 7 months of post-2011 governments*

## Key highlights

- Inflation has exceeded the symbolic %2 rate by the end of the 7th month of the Chahed's rule.
- By the end of the 7th month, the Chahed's Government has performed better than the Jomaa, Laarayedh and Caïd Essebsi's Governments in terms of inflation. It is, however, a weaker performance as compared to the Jebali and Essid's Governments.



Inflation under the government of Youssef Chahed rose from %1.8 to %2.7 between the 6th and the 7th month since he took office. However, the inflation rate was still stable by the end of the 4th month as it did not exceed %2. By the end of the 7th month, the inflation rate under the Chahed's Government was projected at %2.7. The performance of the Chahed's government is consequently weaker than that of Jebali (%2.5) and Essid (%1.9) during the same period. It has still performed better than the government of Jomaa (%3.1) and Laarayedh (%3.2) and much better than the government of Caïd Essebsi (%4.1) over the first 7 since they took office.
